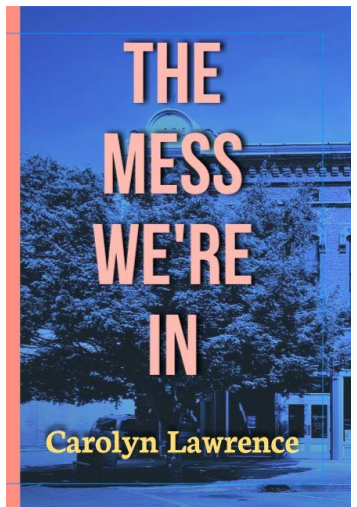


About Carolyn Lawrence
